

WATER INTO WINE

At a wedding feast in Cana, the hosts **ran out of wine**, which risked causing them **deep embarrassment**. **Mary**, knowing her Son's divine power, **approached Jesus about the matter**. Jesus responded, "**My hour has not yet come,**" emphasizing that His actions always aligned with divine timing. **Mary**, confident in His compassion and divine authority, told the servants

demonstrating His divine authority **beyond physical presence**. Though he had no **visible proof**, the man **believed Jesus words** and left. As he traveled home, **his servants met him with the news his son had recovered** at the **exact moment Jesus had spoken**.

DRIVES OUT AN EVIL SPIRIT

In the synagogue at Capernaum, Jesus was teaching when a **man possessed by an unclean spirit suddenly cried out**, recognizing Him as **the Holy One of God**. The demon's voice was filled with fear, knowing **Jesus had the power to destroy it**

MIRACULOUS CATCH OF FISH

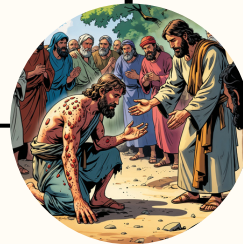

While traveling through the region of Decapolis, people brought to Jesus a man who was deaf and could barely speak. They pleaded with Him for healing. Taking the man aside privately, Jesus placed His fingers into the man's ears, spat, and touched his tongue.



Then, looking up to heaven with deep compassion, He sighed and said, "Ephphatha!"—meaning, "Be opened!"

Instantly, the man's ears were opened, and his speech was restored. Astonished by this miracle, the people proclaimed joyfully, "He has done all things well. He makes the deaf hear and the mute speak!" This miracle highlighted Jesus' compassionate touch and His divine power to restore the fullness of human dignity, fulfilling messianic prophecies about the coming of God's Kingdom

FEEDS 4,000 PEOPLE

A huge crowd had been following Jesus for three days, and they had nothing left to eat. Jesus told His disciples, "I have compassion for these people. I do not want to send them away hungry." The disciples doubted, saying there was no food in the wilderness

PROVIDES A COIN IN A FISH'S MOUTH

RAISES LAZARUS FROM THE DEAD

Lazarus, a **close friend of Jesus**, fell sick and **died in Bethany**. When Jesus arrived, **four days had passed**, and Lazarus was already **buried**. His sisters, Martha and Mary, were grieving, but Jesus **assured** them, **“I am the resurrection and the life.”**



Standing at the tomb, Jesus **wept**, then commanded, **“Lazarus, come out!”** Immediately, Lazarus **walked out of the tomb**, still wrapped in burial cloths. Many believed in Jesus, but the Pharisees **saw this as a threat and began plotting His death**

Two angels appeared, saying, “**He is not here; He has risen!**” The women ran to tell the disciples, but they didn’t believe them at first. Meanwhile, **Mary Magdalene** remained at the tomb weeping. She saw Jesus, but **didn’t recognize Him** until He gently said her name: “**Mary.**” Overwhelmed, she realized He was alive and ran to tell the others

After His crucifixion, **Jesus was buried in a sealed tomb, guarded by Roman soldiers** at the request of the religious leaders. **On the third day**, early Sunday morning, **Mary Magdalene** and **other women** went to the tomb to anoint His body. **When they arrived**, the **stone was rolled away**, and the **tomb was empty**

Later that evening, **Jesus appeared to the disciples** as they were gathered behind locked doors. **He showed them His hands and side**, saying, “**Peace be with you.**” Their sorrow turned to joy. **Thomas, who wasn’t there, doubted their story.** A week later, **Jesus appeared again** and invited **Thomas to touch His wounds.** Thomas fell to his knees and said, “**My Lord and my God!**”



Over the next forty days, **Jesus appeared to many people—including over 500 at once.** He taught, ate with the disciples, and **restored Peter** by asking him three times, “**Do you love Me?**”—reversing Peter’s three denials

Before ascending to heaven, Jesus gave the **Great Commission**, commanding His followers to make **disciples of all nations.** As they watched, He ascended into the clouds, and **angels declared He would return the same way He had gone**

THE SECOND MIRACULOUS CATCH OF FISH

After Jesus’ resurrection, some disciples went fishing on the Sea of Galilee but caught nothing all night. At dawn, **a man on the shore called out, “Cast your net on the right side of the boat.”**



When they did, **they caught 153 large fish, and their nets did not torn.** Realizing it was Jesus, **Peter jumped into the water to reach Him.** This miracle mirrored the first miraculous catch, reaffirming Jesus’ calling for them to be fishers of men
